

PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATION INTERNAL RESPONSE PROCEDURE
(Pursuant to section 3000-B, New York State Public Health Law, As Amended by Chapter 552 of the Laws of 1998)

Internal Response Procedure:

1. Assess the scene for safety before approaching the patient.
2. Assess the patient for unresponsiveness.
3. Assess airway, breathing and circulation.
4. Perform CPR until the defibrillator is applied.
5. Turn on the AED.
6. Stop CPR.
7. Apply pads to the patient's bare chest.
8. Verify that no one is touching the patient and that the patient is not in a puddle of water.
9. Follow the AED's voice and screen prompts for proper shock sequence.
10. Transfer the patient to EMS upon arrival.
11. Complete an EVENT SUMMARY FORM and submit to the PAD Medical Director (*Dr. Michael Leonard*).
